Paul continues teaching the Corinthians about Christian love: "Love isn't rude, it doesn't insist on getting it's own way; it isn't irritable, it doesn't like wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth." (1 Cor. 13:5-6)

Put positively, be: Polite, Considerate, Friendly, and Praise others for doing good things.

God reveals Himself, even names Himself, as Jealous. God's jealousy is a part of His exclusiveness, His uniqueness. There are no other gods.

God is jealous because He created us, yet we insist on replacing Him with false idols: be they other people, other things, or our pride of deciding what's right and wrong for ourselves.

God is jealous for all of you. Are there areas of your life you have yet to entrust to God?

for the Growing Christian:

In Exodus 34:6, God reveals that He is "abounding in steadfast love." The Hebrew words used are rab Rab means "much" chesed. "great," but chesed is not so easy to translate in English - as many as 23 different words can be used, including: "mercy, loving kindness, goodness, loyalty, devotion, faithfulness."

The more we grow in intimacy with God, the more we experience all the different aspects of His chesed love. For now it might be enough to understand that it is a love that God chooses to extend, regardless of all we think is unlovable about ourselves.

Read Ephesians 3:14-19. Paul is praying that Christians grow in the knowledge of Christ's love, even though it surpasses knowledge.

Look for opportunities to experience something new about God's love for you this week.
