Read through Joel one more time. Play a drinking game if you'd like, and take a sip of coffee or tea each time you come across the words "weep, wail, mourn, or cry."

Tears can have a godly function in our lives. Tears can express our repentance. They can drive us to the Lord, and can evoke sympathy from Him

(2 Kings 20:1-6). Tears, on the other hand, may be the only way to express our grief and frustration over things we cannot change. In this way they can have a therapeutic effect and turn us back toward the omniscient God, in whose sovereignty & wisdom we can trust. Tears may be a sign that we share in God's grieving heart over sin in the world. And finally, it's good to remember that tears are something that we can & should share as a community (Rom. 12:15).

## for **Children**:

Use your imagination to create a new kind of insect. It can have special powers, or it can look like a mixture of animals... it can be anything you want! Make a drawing of it, or tell a story about it. Then read Joel 2:4-10. Joel described the movement & destruction of ordinary locusts with military imagery. This was because an actual human army would come in the future and hurt the people of Israel. God would have protected them, and He tried to warn them, but they had decided they didn't want God's help. Read Psalm 145:18-20. If we truly love God and want a relationship with Him, He will always be ready to help!
